3	If any Windows Security Alerts appear with Gilson as the Publisher, select Allow Access.	
4	Log in to TRILUTION LH with the Username Administrator and the Password Admin . (Change the password if prompted.)	
5	Select About on the Liquid Handling menu to view the number of Temporary Days remaining for the software.	
6	Select System Info to view the version information (shown in the title bar). Record the version in the column on the right.
